4 **GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF**
5 **AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR**
6 **OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

7 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the
8 September 2, 2021 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the
9 Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the September 1, 2021 request for an
10 emergency order made by the Superior Court of San Luis Obispo County (“Court”), this Court
11 HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

12 1. With the concurrence of the Presiding Judge, the Court may order that sessions be
13 held anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from
14 September 7, 2021, to October 1, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));

15 2. For purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code
16 sections 313, 315, 334, 631, 632, 637, and 657, from September 7, 2021, to October 1, 2021,
17 inclusive, are deemed holidays because the emergency conditions described in the Order prevent
18 the Court from conducting proceedings or accepting filings as necessary to satisfy these
19 deadlines on those dates (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5)).

20 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.



THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to health and safety concerns resulting in substantial operational impediments, and the proclamations of states of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, it was determined on nineteen prior occasions that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115 were met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of San Luis Obispo (Court). Based on those determinations, and pursuant to the Court's requests, corresponding emergency orders issued authorizing the Court to implement certain relief under Government Code section 68115. Upon the renewed request of Presiding Judge Jacquelyn H. Duffy, it now is determined that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115(a) continue to exist (Gov. Code, § 68115(c)), and it is ordered that the Court is authorized to do the following:

- Hold sessions anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from September 7, 2021, to October 1, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1)); and
- Declare that from September 7, 2021, to October 1, 2021, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 313, 315, 334, 631, 632, 637, and 657, if the above-described emergency conditions prevent the Court from conducting proceedings or accepting filings as necessary to satisfy these deadlines on those dates (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5)).
