On **Thursday, May 4, 2023**, the San Luis Obispo Superior Court will host a variety of Community Law Day activities from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. at the San Luis Obispo Superior Courthouse. Please enter the building through the entrance located at 1050 Monterey Street.

Law Day activities will include presentations by judges on various areas of the law including civil, criminal, family law, and mental health treatment courts. Law Day is observed to celebrate the role of law in our society and to cultivate a deeper understanding of the legal profession. President Dwight Eisenhower established the first Law Day in 1958 to mark the nation's commitment to the rule of law. In 1961, Congress issued a joint resolution designating May 1 as the official date for celebrating Law Day. Every president since then has issued a Law Day proclamation on May 1 to celebrate the nation's commitment to the rule of law.
